thanks be to almighty God, I make & ordain this my last will & Testament that is to say
principally & first of all, I commend my soul to God that gave it me and my body
to the ground in sure & certain hope and to be buried in decent & Christian
manner at the discretion of my Executors, and as for such worldly estate I have
with it hath pleased God to bless me, I give devise and dispose of the same in
the following manner & form, ^{First} I will and it is my desire that all my Just
debts and funeral charges be paid and satisfied secondly I give to my son
Walter Evans Colquitt two feather beds and furniture, with all the house
hold furniture and six head of horses and all the cattle and hogs and sheep
with all the working tools belonging to the plantation and I do desire the
Estate not to be appraised. Then I give and bequeath unto my Grandson
Anthony Terry Carter, one feather bed and furniture. Then I give to my Grand
daughter Christian Colquitt one feather Bed and Counterpane. I do authorize
and appoint my sons Achilles, Walter Colquitt and Martine Carter Executors
of this my last will and Testament making void all other wills ratifying this
my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set

debts and funeral charges be paid and ratified secondly I give to my son
Walter Every Colquitt two feather beds and a furniture, with all the house
hold furniture and six head of horses and all the cattle and hogs and sheep
with all the working tools belonging to the plantation and I do desire the
Estate not to be appraised. Item I give and bequeath unto my Grandson
Anthony Terry Carter, one feather bed and a furniture. Item I give to my Grand
daughter Christian Colquitt one feather Bed and Counterpane. I do authorize
and appoint my sons, Abigail, Walter Colquitt and Martwell Carter executors
of this my last will and Testament making void all other wills, ratifying this
only to be my last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this thirteenth day of December. In the year of our Lord one
