I Daniel Malone of the County of Halifax Being Sick in Body
but of good and sound memory Thanks to almighty God for the
Same do make constitute and ordain this to be my last gift and
Deed hand and seal of all my Estate Whosoever by me made
and declare either by word or writing and this to be taken only
for my last Deed or gift of all my Estate. and None other In
the manner and form Following. Item I give and bequeath
to my Daughter Mary Ivere one Negro Woman Named Milla
to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my
Daughter Elizabeth Traxum one Negro Woman Named Patter
living in Georgia State at my Plantation to her and her heirs
forever. Item I give and bequeath to my Son Thomas one Negro
Girl Named Nelly to him and his forever. Item I give and bequeath
to my Son Nathaniel one Negro Woman Named Molly and one
Negro Boy Named Tom for his Support to be taken in the hand

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Negro Boy named Tom for his Support to be taken in the hands
of them that he makes choice off to live with as long as he live
single life and if he marries to have possession of them to him
and his heirs forever. Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter
Betsey Andrews part of my Land and plantation Whare on I now
live as follows all the Land lying below the mouth of Shephards
Branch and beton the mouth of Tho! Spring Branch to her
and her heirs forever. Item I give and Bequeath to my son Drury
Malone one Hundred acres of Land in Georgia being part of the
Land whare on he now lives on old ~~say~~ Creek on the North side
Side of said Creek one Negro Girl named Molly to him & his heirs
forever for moving my affects to Georgia. Item I give and
Bequeath to my son John the Balance of said Tract of Land
and also one Negro Man named Will to him and his heirs
forever. Item I give and Bequeath to my son James the

I have given named Mary in further deed and furniture as above
to her son and his heirs forever them I give and Bequeath
the same Manse Two Negroes Boys, Boy & Girl and all their
clothes &c and furniture as he has in his possession & what he and
his heirs forever them I give and Bequeath
I myself Daniel all the Land that lies above the mouth of Spring
Branch and above the mouth of that Spring Branch the joining
the river Roanoke and
Bed and furniture Two Cows and calves and one Colt to him
and his heirs forever Now for the settling of the Estate of my late
husband that the debt and dues shall remain Right or Conscience
in any manner of person responsible Whatsoever I do will and
truly uphold Whithin convenient time after my decease
my heirs hereafter named and whatsoever is owing to me by whomever
but with the residue of my Estate by my Executors and Legally bound

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Between Mary Anne Elizabeth Trauern, Daniel Malone
Nathaniel Beecher Andrews and Scamson Banister. Daniel
and I will that one Negro Man named Joney to be sold on Monday
next I do make constitute and appoint, James Anne Clement
