the 8 1756 I Daniel Nye of Kallifac County and Colony of
Virginia Master being in perfect and sound Memory
but finding my Natrall Man to decay do make and
Ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to say, first
and princely I give and Recommend my Soul into the hands
of Almighty God that gave it and my Body to be buried in
such decent maner as my Executors hereafter named shall
see fit hoping to receive it again at the general Resurrection
and as touching such Worldly Estate wherewith it has
pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise and bequeath
the same in following manner and form first after my
lawful Debts is paid I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth
my beloved Wife the third of all my Lands and moveables
and likewise the back of Land which I now live upon
with y^e Houses and ane cird Land also I gave unto
Darby Nye my sonne half of a track of Land call'd Lyn
Crack that is to say the lower part of the sayd Land, and
also to Mary my oldest Doter the upper part of the sayd
Land call'd Joyon Crack also to my Daughter Elizabeth a
Track of Land upon Widgin Creek joining Salmon Harbour
Somay and Lickways a Track of Land of about 200 more
less which I agreed with John Kindrick by Word of Mouth
the Land lying on bothe Creek where y^e said Kindrick

now live. if y^e says Hindrick shall pay sixteen pounds
 Good and Lawfull Money of Virginia to Robert Jones to
 have I do ordain and appoint to be my heire and Toll Exceutor
 at y^e Expiration of three yers and a half insuing from the
 last Day of January last past then the says Robert
 Jones my Recuter to make a titel to y^e says Hindrick
 for the says Land on Roovers Creek and it is my desire
 that y^e Money arising from it may be for Scholing my
 Children. and if y^e says Hindrick doe not make y^e pay
 by the time above menthoned to fall to the wult of my
 Recuter for Scholing my Children and other Bites or
 Entrees which I made I desire that my Recuter may
 make Sayel of to pay my Debts and clear my Lands
 It is my desire that my Recuter shall pay my son in
 posshion at twenty one yers of Age and my
 Daughters at eighteen yers of Age in witness
 hereof I have herunto set my hand and Seal the Day
 and Year above Written Send Seal and Declaird
 by the says Daniel Bryen as his last Will and
 Testament in the presence of us the subscribers

of an Executor and with Thomas Jones and Isaac Vantabon
his Securities entered into and acknowledged Bond

obtaining approbate of the said Will in due form
