In the name of God Amen the Eight day of February in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and eighty five John Brown Sen^r of Guilford County being sick and weak of body but of perfect Mind and Memory of willing to mind the frailty of my mortal Body do make this my last will and testament in manner and form as follows that I do say first I recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it nothing doubting but shall at the Resurrection Receive the same I also give the said Soul and Body of as to my Body I recommend it to the Earth to be Buried in a decent and Christian like manner at the Discretion of my Executors and as touching such worldly Estate as when death it has pleased God to Bless me in this life I do make my will and dispose of in manner & form as follows

I do give and bequeath my daughter Mary a Negro wench named Rachel and her five Children hereafter named (with all their increase) Fanny, Sissy, Amy, Jesse Charon during her Natural life and at her Decease them and all their increase shall be Equally divide amongst her then Surviving Children to them and their heirs forever.

I do give and bequeath to my Grand daughter Sally Brooks Daniel a Negro Girl named Edy with all her increase to her and her heirs forever.

I do give and bequeath to my Grandson John Brooks Parker a Negro woman named Nell with all her increase except three Children to wit Phoe Edy & Milly to him and his heirs forever But Provided the above John Brooks Parker shall die without heir lawfully Begotten of his Body then the above named Nell with all her increase except the above named Phoe Edy & Milly and their increase shall be equally divided amongst my three Sons hereafter named and their Representatives to wit John Perren
