 in Court & sworn to by 3 Witnesses, ^{being the said Nathl. Oldwell} to be the last Will of the said Oldwell Decd. & was
 read & recorded; and on the Motion of the said Nathl. Oldwell who made Oath according to Law
 together with Edgar Burlington James Jones & Ebenezer Fawcett his security entered into and
 gave their bond in the penalty of Twenty thousand Dollars Condition as the said Bonds
 Certificate for obtaining probate thereof in due form is granted them &
