Item I give unto my Son John Wyatt four head of cattle to him his heirs &c Item I give unto my Grand Daughter Joanna Bayntum one heifer Item I give unto my Daughter Rebekah Wyatt 1 Bed and furniture & a horse to her — her heirs &c Item I give unto my Son Richard Wyatt two Beds & furniture one last & year of Years and all the remaining part of my Estate to be equally divided between my sons Richard and Rebekah Wyatt to them their heirs &c I hereby constitute and ordain my Son Richard Wyatt Horatio Wade and Guy Jay Bayntum Executors to this my last will & testament so witnessed this 20<sup>th</sup> day of December 1787.
