Item the above Anne my Daughter is in possession already of two Negroes of the above bequeath to wit Sam & Florid Twelve pounds two Shillings and a Bed and Bundle a Bed and furniture Five Cans & Calves two Ewes and Lamb five fat Hogs Eleven Hundred weight of Tobacco and Ninety one pounds twelve Shillings a side of Seal Leather two Beavers Item I give and Bequeath to my son Eben Bagland all the Remainder of my land that is not already Bequeathed Including the Dring House and joining also laying below the land that is to Run from Epps Lane to Mary Parkers land

and joining Lovelace to Banister and up Banister to my
Young Branch to the corner thence East to the New
line where on my Son John comes to him and his then for
the Item I give and Bequeath to my son Evan Bagland
a Horse & a Riding Chair at thirty Pounds price one
bed and furniture Eight Hundred weight of Nut Pork
and five two year old Hogs and five Sows of one year
old one Steer of four years old and five Cows & Calves
two Ewes and lambs one Painted Chest and six Center
Plates two gallon Basins ^{two} middle Sized Dishes one
small Black walnut Chest it being the best that I have

trunks one new and one old Two Basins & Two Dishes
of this size as is above Bequeathed to her Brother Even
Six Pewter Plates also Two Hundred Pounds in Cash
to be paid in Gold or Silver to her and her heirs forever
Then it is my will and desire and do hereby order that if
my Daughter Anna Die With ^{out} her lawfully begotten
in her Body that then the said Estate shall be equally
divided amongst my Children To wit John Lipscomb
Anne and Evan or their legal Representatives which
I give to them their Heirs and assigns forever Then
it is my will and desire that the sum of twenty one Pounds

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shall be raised out of the Sale of Such of my Estate as yet
Remains herein ungiven Except Two Negroes To wit
Dick and Milley as soon as it shall be collected after the
Sale or Sales of Such Credit as shall be given of my Estate
That is not herein Bequeathed I Give and Bequeath
to my son Evan Ragland Two Negroes the last mentioned
to wit Dick and Milley To him and his heirs forever
it is my Will and I Give and Bequeath accordingly Order that
in case my said son Evan should die without Issue
lawfully Begotten that then the said Land herein
above given shall be sold and the money arising
from Such Sale be Equally divided amongst the
Rest of my Children To wit John Lipscomb ^{James} John
or their legal Representatives which I Give to the
their Heirs and assigns forever Lastly I constitute
nominate and appoint my son John Ragland

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Agland and Evan Agland and Henry Wapson
Executors of this my last will and Testament Wholly
Revolving and Disannulling all and every other Testimony
by me herebefore ^{made} In Witness whereof I have hereunto
Set my hand and affixt my seal this thirtieth day
November in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand
Seven Hundred and ninety two
