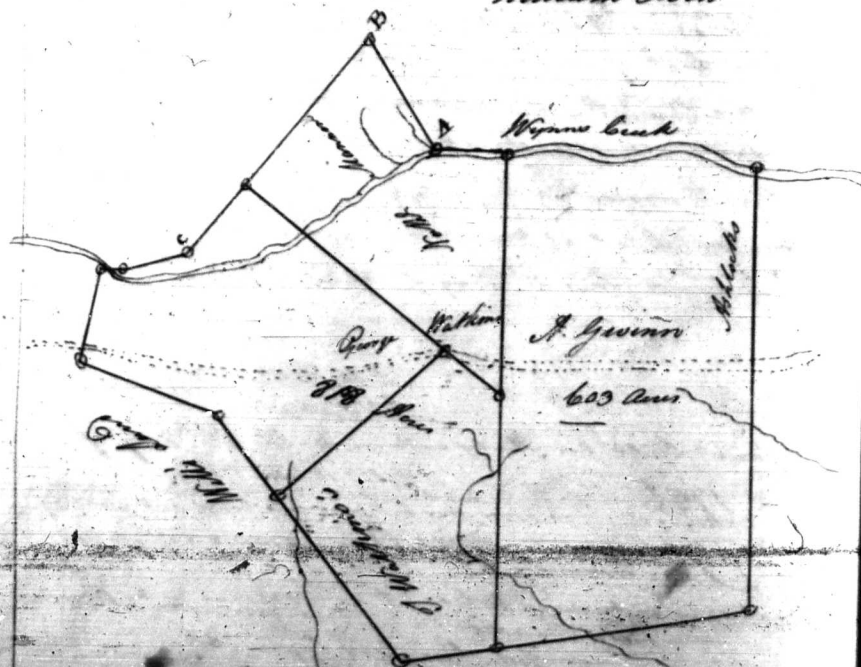

my Cattle and Goods of every kind to her use during her life or widowhood and
if my Wife should die she may sell the land and apply the profit arising there
from towards the bringing up my Children and if my Wife should not sell
the Land during her life or widowhood it is my will that it be then sold
together with all the remainder of my Estate Goods and Cattle and equally
divided among all my Children and do constitute and appoint Charles Mullens
son and my Wife Sarah Jones Executors and Executrix of this my last and only
will and testament
