In the name of God amen the 22nd of Nov^r 1786 - I William Moore of Halifax County being very sick in body but thanks to God for it in my perfect memory & Calling to mind the mortality of my body I that it is appointed for all men once to Die I do constitute and ordain this my Last will & Testament & as Touching the worldly Goods where with it has Pleas'd God to bless me I Give and dispose in the manner & form following Viz In the first place I Give my Son William Moore Two Shillings & Six Pence Sterling. Item I Give my Grandson James Moore my Bed & Turnature. Item I Give my Granddaughter Ruth one Twine one Negro Girl Named Sarah to her & her heirs Lawfully Begotten of her Body & if she the sd Ruth die Leaving no heir of her body then the said Negro Sarah & her increase to the Next of her Surviving Sisters & her heirs Item I Give to my Son in law John Echols all my Corn & Fodder & leave with the sd John Echols one malattow Boy Child & one Gray horse / the Child is Named Allen / with all & Every part & Parcel of my Estate unmentioned to be sold To the highest Bider To pay my Debts & after my Debts are paid if any thing Remains I Give it To my friend Samuel John Echols. This is my last will & Testament
