 certainty of Death and the Uncertainty of Life
 Knowing it is Appointed for all men once to Die do
 make constitute and appoint this to be my Last
 Will and Testament humbly Giving my soul
 to Almighty God that Gave it me and my body to
 be decently buried at the Discretion of my here after
 named Executors and as for what worldly Estate

wherewith is thus bequeathed to my wife and her
 life I give and bequeath in manner and form follow-
 ing VIZ First I leave all my right standing Debts
 and my Negro woman that I lent to my Daughter
 Elizabeth Wade Vained Dolly and my white Riding
 mare and my bay horse and my silver watch to be sold
 to Discharge my just Debts and if any Remainding
 I give to my two sons Josiah and Moses Farley to
 be Equally Divided between them. Then I give to
 my Beloved Wife Mary Farley the bed and furniture
 that we commonly make use of and my Chest of Draw-
 ers and my Iron Chair to Dispose of to whom she
 pleases of her children. Then I Lend to my Beloved wife
 after the Expiration of six years from the Date here
 of my Negro man Stephen and my Negro Girl pats
 the use of them During her Natural life and After her
 Decease I give my Negro man Stephen to my son
 Josiah Farley to him and his heirs and assigns
 Forever, and I give my Negro Girl pats to my son
 Moses Farley to him and his heirs and assigns
 Forever, Then I give my Daughter Mary Burton
 Five Shillings Current Money and I Lend to her Af-
 ter the Expiration of six Years my Negro Girl Judah
 During her Natural life and after her Decease I
 give my said Negro Girl Judah with her Increase
 if any to my Granddaughter Mary Burton to her
 and her heirs forever. I Give to my son George
 Farley Five Shillings Current Money. Then I give
 to my Daughter Elizabeth Wade my Negro Girl
 that my Negro woman Dolly Brought to her and
 her heirs Forever Also I give to her five Shilling
 Current Money. Then I give to my Daughter

Providence doth my Negs Girl Tab (fornid Over) Brought
 Over) Item I Give to my son John James Farley my Ne-
 gre man Ned to him and his heirs and Assigns forever
 Item I Give to my Daughter Martha Wade Son David
 Current Money to be Paid by my here after named Exr
 at the Expiration of six years from the Date hereof
 Item I Give to my son Josiah Farley all my Land and
 Plantations, and to Pay my son Moses Farley Thirty Pound
 Current Money at the Expiration of six Years, To him
 and his heirs and Assigns forever also I Give to my
 son Josiah Farley after the Expiration of six years
 From the Date hereof my Negre man Robin and my
 Negre woman Lucy and her Increase if any from
 the date hereof to him and his Heirs and Assigns
 forever, Item I Give ^{to my son} Moses Farley after the Expiration
 of six Years From the date here of my Negre man
 Mark and my Negre boy Bob to him and his
 heirs and Assigns forever Also I Give to him
 my Hair Cloth when he Come of Age to him and his
 heirs and Assigns forever, Item I Give to my two
 sons Josiah Farley and Moses Farley after the Ex-
 piration of six Years From the Date hereof all the
 Remainder of my Estate that is not already Given
 to be Equally Divided between them to them and
 their heirs and Assigns forever. Item I do make
 and appoint my two sons Josiah Farley and Moses
 Farley whole and sole Exr^{tie} of this my last
 Will and testament Revoking all other wills
 whatsoever heretofore made by me as witness wh-
 reof I have set my hand and seal this Twentieth third
 day of August one thousand seven hundred and
 sixty seven Attest the Name Scott was

Intended Before Assignment. And the mention
 of six years is to be from the date hereof Henry.
 Truly Ld. signed sealed and Acknowledged in presence
 of Henry Hardin, David Griffin, William Powell,
 John Campbell. At a Court held for Hals
 for County the 21 Day of July 1768. This will was
 presented in Court by Josiah Farley one of the Exors
 therein named Who made Oath thereto according
 to Law & the same being by the Oaths of the several
 witnesses thereto was ordered to be Recorded & Certified
 to Granted to the said Executor for Obtaining a Pro-
 bate thereof in due form, he having with John
 Frederick Mutter & Jno. Price his securities
 entered into & Acknowledged Bond according to Law
 and liberty is reserved for Moses Farley the other
 Executor, join in the said probate when he shall
 think fit.
