 Very Sick and Weak though in perfect Sense
 and Memory Knowing ^{the} Mortality of my body do
 resign my soul into the hands of God that Gave it
 me and my Body to Earth from whence it came to be
 buried in a Christian Like Decent manner at
 the Disposal of my Ex^{or} hereafter Named
 and do herein Make and Ordain this My Last
 Will Testament. In the first place I Desire all
 my lawful debts to be paid out of my Estate
 Then I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved Wife
 Mrs Taylor all my whole Estate Real and perso-
 nal to her and her heirs forever and do Give and
 Ordain My Beloved Wife Ales Taylor my whole
 and sole Ex^{or} of this my Last will Testament
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and Affixed my seal This 12 day of Decem^r 1768
