At about half for Halifax County the 19th day of January 1786
This last will and Testament of Daniel Carley was Exhibited into Court and proved by the Oaths of three of the witnesses thereto Vouched to be true and on the motion of Matthew Sanderson, Daniel Carley Daniel Carley and Isaac Carley Executors therein named where made Oath hereto according to Law heretofore is granted for obtaining probate hereof in due form they giving security where upon they together with George Wood James Smith and Benjamin Dickson their Trustees and assigns do and shall

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In the name of God Amen the fourth day of November in the year of our Lord Jesus Christ one thousand seven hundred and eighty five I, Isaac Carlin of Halifax County being very sick and weak of body but of perfect mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say after all my legal debts and funeral charges are justly paid I give and dispose of in the following manner and form I give unto my son Joseph Carlin one dark bay Horse that goes by the name of Silver Eye, his choice of a feather bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever I give and bequeath unto my son George Carlin one bright bay mare given by the name of Lady Tom Colt and a feather bed and furniture his most choice to him and his heirs forever I give unto my son Horatio three or four sets of Table silver spoons, I give unto my Daughter Patsy Segson one Gold Ring and all my wearing clothes the Ring to be made to her desire of Gold that I have behind and to help for Army Estate. I do also desire that all the rest of my Estate consisting of Horses, Cattle, Hogs and Sheep and all my household furniture of every kind may be equally divided between my sons Robert Wade, Richard Wade and John Wade and Joseph Carlin & George Carlin in the following manner that it shall be Lawfully appraised, and then equally Divided agreeable to the appraisement And I do hereby constitute and appoint my Trusty friends George Boyd and John Faulkner Executors of this my last will and Testament utterly revoking and annulling all other Wills by me made Confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 11th day of November 1785.

Halifax County being sick and weak of body but of perfect mind and
Memory thanks be to God therefore Calling to mind the mortality of my
body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make
and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form
following that is to say principally and first of all I give my body
to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like and decent manner
at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned and as to touch-
ing such worldly Estate where with it hath pleased God to bless
me I give and dispose in the following manner and form I bequeath
and unto my loving wife Mary Cory my whole Estate consisting of
Negroes Horses Cattle and all my stock Household furniture the
Trest of land and Plantation where I now live and every
part of my Estate that I at present own or shall hereafter acquire

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Natural life or widowhood and at her marriage or decease I desire
it may be Divided as follows to wit I give and bequeath unto my
son Harrison Cory one Negro boy named Harry to him and his heirs
forever And whereas I have at present three negro women who perhaps
may have children to make the rest of my Childrens Estate Equivalent
with my son Harrison in respect of the Negro boy bequeathed him I desire
that my Children may have and Estate Equal to my said intention
I provided my aforesaid wenchs becom sufficient and if then Estates come
Equal to his when they come of age I desire that all my whole Estate may
be divided between my Children hereafter named vizt. Alexander, Jesse
Benjamin, Molly, Esley, Rebecca, Nancy, Harrison & Robert to them and
their heirs forever I further desire that if my said wife should marry or
decease before my Children come of age that my negro's may be hired out
and the money thereon arising be put to the use of bringing up and Educa-
ting my Children in as regular a manner as my Estate will admit of
but if in case any of my aforesaid Children should die without
heir I desire that shall be Equally divided between the living Children
I give and bequeath unto my eldest son Alex and or Cory my whole
set of Smiths tools and desire he may be improv'd by some skilful
mechanic Capable of teaching and instructing him in the art of silvers
Smith if he my said son chooses And I do here by appoint my worthy
friend Abner Wade and my son Alexander Cory Executors of
this my last Will and Testament utterly revoking and disannulling all
other wills by me made Confirming this and no other to be my last will
Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the
7th day of August 1785
