In Obedience to an Order of Halifax Court bearing date September 1786

We the Undersigned being Just Clerks have divided the following Slaves (to wit) Mary, Dinah, Betty, Gloucester, Sage, Hannah, Simon, Polly, Dinah, Isaac, Deborah & Ralph being of the Estate of Francis Wallington Deceased between the several claimants thereto and of the said Slaves the allotment their equal or due share respectively in the following manner (to wit) To Mr. Benjamin Whitten in Right of his Wife Rebecca late Widow of said Francis Wallington Deed of her thirds in the following Slaves (to wit) Mary, Dinah, Deborah, Isaac, Ralph, Betty, Gloucester, Sage, Hannah, Simon, Polly, Dinah, Isaac, Deborah & Ralph

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Slaves to wit, Page and Isaac, save that the said Nancy shall pay to her Brother Edward Wallington the sum of five pounds and to her sister Frances Wallington the sum of twelve pounds ten Shillings - To Annabell Wallington son of said Francis Wallington and of her equal share in the following Slaves (to wit) Dinah and Ralph

save that the said Annabell shall pay to his Brother Edward Wallington the sum of seven pounds ten Shillings -

To Edward Wallington son of said Francis Wallington Deed of his equal share in the following (to wit) Hannah and Polly together with the sums of money above mentioned to the amount of twelve Pounds ten Shillings

To Francis Wallington daughter of said Francis Wallington Deed of her equal share in the following Slaves (to wit) Betty & Deborah together with the above mentioned sum of twelve Pounds ten Shillings -

A further Division of the Estate of the said Francis Wallington Deed at present cannot be had, given under our hands this 11th Day of April 1782
