a Christian like and decent manner at the Discre
tion of my Executors here after named nothing doubting
but at the general resurrection of the dead I shall
Resume the same again by the Mighty power of God
and as for what worldly Estate it hath pleased God
to bless me within this life I Give Bequeath and
dispose of in the following manner I leave the place
where on I lived to be sold two hundred acres of land
to pay my just debts and to school my Children & the
rest for the use of my family and the rest of the land
