Joan, Jesse & Jesse my Estate Personal to be Equally divided
Amongst them at the Death or marriage of their mother
I appoint my wife Susanna Young Executrix and Thomas
Watkins Senr & William Wilson Executors to this my last
will and Testament, Revoking all other wills by me made
