and in a low state of health, but of sound mind and memory. Thanks be to God for the same. Do
make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament in form and manner following: First my
desire is for the land and plantation wherein I now live. I thought of Antony Wilkerson to be sold, and
the money arising therefrom to be apply'd to paying my just debts. Then I give and bequeath all
my negroes that came by my wife to my wife Patsy Dennis and my two children Mary Ann
Dennis and William Dennis to be equally divided between them. Also I give and bequeath to my wife
