Pott and Frying Pan and one Young Steifer also one

Bacon and two Plates and pair of fenders also the Rent of
 the aforesaid Plantation to be due to my Son
 William after my Decease till my Son John comes
 of age also one Bay Horse and his increase of My desire
 is that Thomas Fairis may see the things left to my
 Son John forth coming or the value of them when
 he is of age also that Joseph Fairis see the things
 left my Son William forth coming when he is of
 age also I appoint Joseph Fairis my trustee
 to collect in my just debts due and also pay of
 my just debts etc.
