Item - I constitute and ordain my Brothers Perry
and Royal Daniel sole and whole Executors of the
my last Will and Testament wholly disallowing
and revoking all and every other Will and Testament

or any granting and allowing this and no other to be
my Will and Testament that I will have executed
after my Death In Witness whereof I have hereunto

Daniel his Security entered into Bond
