Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Moody two
Negroes Viz. Phill & Jennie to her and her heirs forever
Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Wallington
two Negroes Viz. Hannah and Daphney which Paul Wallington
has in possession and one hundred pounds Virginia Currency
to be paid unto her by my Executors hereafter mentioned

Wallington one Negro Girl named Winny to her and her heirs
forever All the Residue of my Property both real & personal
after all my Lawfull Debts are paid I Give and bequeath
to my two sons William Thompson and James Thompson to be
Equally Divided between them at their own discretion and
Do also appoint the said William Thompson and James Thompson
Jointly my Executors In Witness Whereof I have hereunto

and seal this seventh Day of November in the year our Lord
Jesus Christ one thousand seven Hundred and eighty five

to Law
