I am about to die do make and constitute this my last will  
& testament bearing to mind and Memory what worldly goods it hath please  
God to in Dow me with to give and dispose of them in the following manner  
I give unto my son Edmon Webb a negro Man Jack if the said  
Jack shall live to make three crops the sd Edmon Webb shall pay for  
Estate 1250 pounds of real crop tobacco or the value in case to be divided  
among the Rest of my Children & after My debts is paid the Rest of my Estate  
to be Equally divided between the other three Children namely George Webb  
Susaner Whitlock Betty Gary I do point Edmond Webb Wm Mather  
Executors to this my last will and testament in the year of our Lord 1794

Go to in Dow me with Do give and dispose of them in the following manner  
Item; I give unto my son Edmond Webb a Negro Man Jack if the said  
Jack shall live to make three Crops the 3<sup>d</sup> Edmond Webb shall Pay for  
Estate 125<sup>0</sup> pounds of sweet Crop tobacco or the value in case to be divided  
among the Rest of my Children. After My debts is paid the Rest of my Estate  
to be Equally divided between the other three Children namely George Webb  
Susaner Whitlock Betty Gary I do point Edmond Webb Wm. Mackay  
Executors to this my last will and Testament in the Year of our Lord 1794.

At a Court held for Halifax County the 2<sup>d</sup> day of December 1794  
The within written last will & Testament of Jos. Webb Dec<sup>d</sup> presented  
in Court & Proved by the Oath of 2 witnesses there <sup>subscribed</sup> & ordered to be Recorded  
And at another Court held for said County the 2<sup>d</sup> of January 1795  
And on the motion of Edmond Webb one of the Executors named in the said

Will & Testament of John Webb's who made Cath According to Law & together  
with John Collins & James Eastman his Securitys entered into & Acknowledge their  
bond in the penalty of Six hundred Dollars Conditioned as the said Deeds Certificate  
on obtaining Probate thereof in due form is granted him
