well in my last will and disposing mind and memory and
knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, and that it is my duty to make
and execute this my last will and Testament in manner and form following
that is to say Primarily and first of all I give and Recommend my
soul into the hands of God that gave it, and my body to the earth to be
buried in a Christian like and Decent manner at the discretion of my
Executors and as touching such worldly goods as it hath pleased almighty
God to give me with I give devise and Dispose of as follows

I give and devise to my Daughter Anne Green £ 100 to be paid to her

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I am I give to my son Doel to have a good horse and saddle to him and his heirs forever. — I am I have unto my wife Anne while all the best of my ^{estate} both Real and Personal during her life or widowhood and at her death or marriage it is my will that my said son be equally Divided, among my three sons, William Doel and Doel to him and their heirs forever. — Further it is my will that at the death or marriage of my wife that all the Real Estate of my estate be it of what kind it may (not heretofore mentioned) be equally Divided among my three Girls namely Mary, Anne & Elizabeth to him and his heirs forever. — I Constitute and Appoint my wife Anne while she lives and my son William while he lives to be my last will and Testament, with power to alter and amend the same. Given under my hand and seal this 15th day of May 1789
