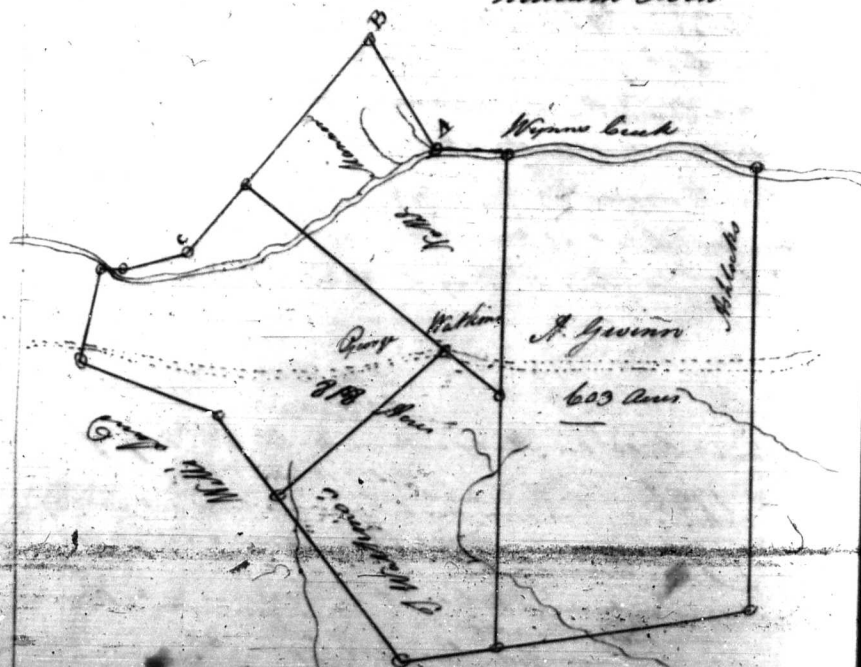

1782 in the Subscribers have allotted and divided
the Lands devised by George Watkins Test among the
several Legatees and that too in a manner in our Judg-
ments at least agreeable to the last Will of the Testator
and according to the mutual consent of the Parties given
under our hands this 15th Day of May 1783

In Name of God amen I Job Jones of Halifax
County and State of Virginia being at this time very weak in body but
of Sound Mind and Memory (thanks be to God) do make this my last will
and testament bearing date this fifteenth day of March in the year of our
first one thousand seven hundred and eighty one. Afterly revoking and
making void all former wills and testaments made by me and declaring this
my last and only will and testament in manner and form following. I
bequeath my Soul into the hands of Almighty God and my
body to the Earth to turn to dust Hoping thro the Merits of my Saviour to raise
again to life everlasting. Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife
Sarah Jones all my personal estate Goods and Cattle for her use during
her widowhood paying all debts that shall come against the Said Estate or
to discharge my self More clearly it is my will that my beloved Wife Sarah Jones
shall have the plantation ~~where I now live~~ with all my Land and all
my Cattle and Goods of every kind to her use during her life or widowhood and
if my Wife should die she may sell the land and apply the profit arising there
from towards the bringing up my Children and if my Wife should not sell
the Land during her life or widowhood it is my will that it be then sold
together with all the remainder of my Estate Goods and Cattle and equally
divided among all my Children and do constitute and appoint Charles Mullens
son and my Wife Sarah Jones Executors and Executrix of this my last and only
will and testament
