In the Name of God Amen. I Epaphroditus Sydnor of
Halifax County being Sick & weak of Body but of perfect sense and
memory. Thanks to Almighty God for the same and Calling to mind
the mortality of my Body that it is appointed for all men
once to die, do here make my last Will & Testament in
manner and form following. In Testimonis. I lend to my beloved
Wife Alice Sydnor all my Estate real and personal during
her Widowhood to a wife and maintain my Children on, And
in case my said Wife doth marry. Then I lend to my said Wife
one Negro Girl named Joan, one feather Bed & Furniture, one
Horse and four head of Cattle during her natural life. Like-
wise my Will and desire is that my said wife shall peacefully
possess my House & Plantation whereon I now live during her
Life without interruption, Item I give
William Sydnor my Tract of Land whereon I now live containing
two hundred & fifty acres (at the Death of my said wife) To him
and his heirs forever, Item my will is that if my said Wife
doth marry, that then all the residue of my Estate, except
my Land & the above mentioned Negro Girl Joan and the Bed
and Stock lent to my said wife during life, shall be equally
divided among my four Children, VIZ Elizabeth, Judith,
William, Molly and Berkeley, but in case any of my
