In the name of God amen I Jonathan Davis of Halifax
County being in low state of health but sound mind and memory
do make this my last will and Testament in manner and form
as followeth To wit I Give and bequeath to my Beloved wife
Barbula Davis one feather Bed & furniture I also lend her my
two horses three pewter Basins one pewter Dish and four plates
so long as she may live then at her death I give the above
last property to my son Benjamin Davis to him & his heirs forever
I Give to my son Adam Davis one white face Huffer and
one Bunkle Huffer, four head of Hogs one pewter Basin and
one pewter Dish to him and his heirs forever

Item my will and desire is that my Grand son Jeph Davis
shall have ten Dollars paid to him out of my Estate when he
comes of age -

Then after all my just Dells are paid all the balance and residue
of my estate not above mentioned I give and bequeath to my son
Benjamin Davis to him and his heirs forever I hereby nominate
and appoint my wife Burheba Davis and my son Benjamin

 for obtaining his late Will in due form is granted

 Henry Cook his Secretary Entered Into & acknowledged
 Bond in the penalty of \$500 conditioned according
 to Law
