In the Name of God Amere. I, John Adam Link
of the state of Virginia, County of Halifax, being of sound
disposing mind and Memory, do make and Ordain this my last
Will & Testament in manner and form following, that is to say,
First I will that all my just debts and funeral charge be paid
and be charged by my Executors hereafter named. Also I give and
bequeath unto my son Boston Link, Ten pound Virginia Money
to be paid him after his Mothers death by the Executors.

Also I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Link this Tract of Land
whereon I now live Containing two Hundred & sixty seven Acres
more or less with all appertan: houses, orchards, and so forth.

Then I give or lend to my dear and loving wife for the term of her life
all the Remaind of my Estate. I reserve after the death of my wife
Sarah Link that all the remainder of my Estate be sold & equally
divided between William Link Senior & my son John Link & my
Daughter Peggy Foster, & my Daughter Sarah Warner and my Daugh-
ter Milley Warren. And I do ^{constitute and} appoint William Link & Thomas Link
Executors of this my last Will and Testament and Trustee for my Wife.

At a Court held for Halifax County the 27th day of April 1789
The within written last Will and Testament of John A. Link deceased was
exhibited with due and proved by the oath of his witnesses hereunto duly

to law, certificate for obtaining probate was granted him in due
form he giving security. Whereupon he together with James Holt
and John Graves his securities entered into & acknowledged Bond
for that Purpose according to Law.

In the name of God amere I, John Kent of
Halifax County & State of Virginia, being sick and weak but of perfect
sense & memory thanks be to God for it do make, constitute, ordain, and
appoint this my last Will and Testament in manner and form follows
ing (to wit). — I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah Kent
the land and plantation whereon I now live, for and during her widow-
hood, together with my two Negroes Joe and Poll.

I give, ^{and bequeath} to my daughter Polly Kent, my Negro girl Alice and
her Increase, to her & her heirs forever.

I give and bequeath to my son Robert Kent, my Negro boy Ja-
mes, to him & his heirs forever. I give to my son John Kent my
Negro girl named Rose, to him and his heirs forever.

I give & bequeath to my son Smith Kent my Negro boy
Nancy & his share and his heirs forever, and when the eldest of my
heirs, comes of age, my will and Desire is, that my Negroes, George
Ben, and Poll be equally divided between all my children, I give
to my son Robert Kent, my Negro boy Ben to him and his heirs
forever. my Will and Desire is that two Hundred pounds be raised out
of my Estate, and advanced in Land for my son John Kent. Also it
is my Will, that two hundred pounds be likewise raised out of my Estate
and advanced in Land for my son Smith Kent; my will is that my
son Robert Kent shall have his choice of my Guns, and that
