In the name of God. Amen. I, Nath. Bowman

Bowman of the County of Halifax being sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say first I desire that

my Just debts and funeral charges be paid.

Item I further am as according Order made all my debts of every kind and nature after paying all my Just debts and funeral charges apportioned to the Property of my brother John Bowman which I now do bequeath to him his heirs and assigns forever. Item 2, and bequeath to the said John Bowman the Land to which I'm entitled to as survivor to the said Jersey here in continental service also the whole sum of money due me in the hands of John Turner merchant at New York and also the sum of three thousand dollars current at New York in the State of New Jersey with no interest thereon due all which I give to him his heirs and assigns forever Item 3 also aware that my executors hereafter named do not in my Estate Purchase a sum of general charge for Mr John Hicks his lady and son which I give to each of them \$100. Lastly as Testimony and appoint my friend John Hicks my Brother John Bowman Executors of this my last Will and Testament Ratifying and Confirming to be my last Will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this seventh day of July one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Nine.

writing of the said Goss & was caused to be preserved this the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of February  
the said Executor who made oath returning to the Clerk's office for the sealing  
a Probate of the said will in due form is Granted him whereupon he doth  
with Edmund King & John Breckinridge his Surety enter into & acknowledge  
this bond for that purpose according to Law, Reserving Right to John Ba.  
the other Executor herein named to file in the Probate when he shall arrive to  
lawful age.
