make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following
First I Commit my Body to the Earth to be Buried in a decent manner
at the discretion of my Executors or Executors and my Soul into the
hands of allmighty God who first Give it and as for my worldly estate
as it hath been please God to possess me with I Give and bequeeth in
manner and form following. Inprimas — I Give and bequeeth to my
Daughter Suannah Bocher one Negro wench named Rachil and her
Child Harry one negro Girl named Sarah together with their increase
to her and heirs for ever also John a negro man to her and her heirs forever
I Give and bequeeth unto my Son Richard Bocher one Negro
boy named Sam and the upper part of my Land bounded as followeth
from the upper Corner on the River Stanton and down the said River to
the Spring Branch up the same a straight line to the Back line to him his
heirs or assigns forever also one negro Girl named Phillis and her increase
to him and his heirs forever. Itam — I Give and bequeeth to my son
James Bocher the lower part and Remainder of my Land together

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Bequeath to my Beloved wife Frances during her natural life the use of all my land together with the Remainder of all my Slaves Stock of horses Cattle Sheep and hogs plantation utensils all my kitchen and household Furniture after my funeral expence and Just debts are paid and at her death to be equally divided between my three Children Susannah Booker Richard Booker and James Booker never the less if my Beloved wife should think proper to Give either of my Children any Slave or Stock or household furniture before her death the gift shall be Good only the Value deducted out of that Childs part on a division after her death and I do hereby appoint my beloved wife Frances Booker Guardian to my three Children Richard Booker Susannah Booker and James Booker and I do hereby appoint my loving wife Executrix and James McCraw son my Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby Revoking all other Wills before me made and I do hereby publish and declare this my last will and Testament In witness hereof I have set my hand and seal this 25th day of April in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and eighty one

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In the Name of God Amen John Wade of Halifax County being Weak in body the of sound and perfect understanding do constitute this my last will and Testament and Desire it to be Recd. by all Viz— I Do Give and bequeath to my son Edmund Wade two Negroes Namd Deary & Ben A fether Bed & Furniture to him & his heirs forever— I Do Give and bequeath to my son Allen Wade two Negroes Namd George & Isbelle A fether Bed & Furniture to him & his heirs forever— I Do Give and bequeath unto my son Tinsley Wade two Negroes Namd Peter & young Hannah A fether Bed & Furniture to him & his heirs forever— I Do Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Wade two Negroes Namd Charles & Zedek A fether Bed and Furniture to her & her heirs forever— I Do Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Polly Wade two Negroes Namd John & James A fether Bed and Furniture to her & her heirs forever— I Do Give unto my Daughter Pally Wade two Negroes Namd Jane & Fane A fether Bed and Furniture to her & her heirs forever— I Do Give unto my Grand Daughter Polly Wade two Negroes Namd Archer & Palt A fether Bed and Furniture to her & her heirs forever— I Do Give and bequeath unto my Daughters Elizabeth Price & Jane Gwinn all the property that I had Lent them to them & there heirs forever— I Do Desire that John Gwinn take my three Children Tinsley Polly & Pally and I Do Send unto John Gwinn two Negroes Namd Tom & Menda to raise & Educate these Children untill they become of age or Marry then these two Negroes to be sold & the Money Equally Divided among all my Children also. I Do Send John Gwinn one hundred pounds out of the Estate for the space of fifteen years then this Money to be Divided Equally among all my Children— I Desire that my Land may be sold with my Negroes after Mary Well Hannah Luce & Saml Hark of all Kinds & when Twelve Eighteen Months Credit to be Given the money that the Land & Fatches to be Equally Divided among my three Sons Except the hundred pounds Gwinn has the money the Negroes & Stock & Fatches to be Equally Divided among all my Children after my Just debts being paid— I Do Desire that John Gwinn Robert Wade and Edmund Wade may be my Sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Eleventh day of April in the year of our Lord 1786
