 James Taylor of the County of Halifax being
 Very sick and weak though in perfect Sense
 and Memory Knowing ^{the} Mortality of my body do
 Refuse my soul into the hands of God that Gave it
 me and my Body to Earth from whence it came to be
 buried in a Christian like Decent Manner as
 the Disposal of my Ex^{tr} hereafter Named
 and do herein Make and Ordain this My last
 Will Testament. In the first place I Desire all
 my lawful debts to be paid out of my Estate.
 Then I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved Wife
 Alice Taylor all my whole Estate Real and perso
 nal to her and her heirs forever and do Live and
 Ordain My Beloved Wife Alice Taylor my whole
 and soul Executors of this my last will Testament
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and Affixed my seal this 12 day of Decem^{ber} 1768
