Halifax County Virginia Wills 1798-1804

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In the Name of God amen, I Nathan Moore of Halifax County being of sound mind & memory, and in consideration of the uncertainty of life, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament, in form and manner as follows. 1st My desire is that my body be decently buried, then my funeral expenses and my just debts be first paid, then the residue of my Estate, to be left and divided as follows. 2nd I give and bequeath unto my wife, Eliza Moore during her natural life or widowhood, all the property I possess, of every kind and when she dies or marries, to be divided as follows. 3rd I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Alexander Moore, one negro man named Adam. 4th I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Elizabeth Moore, one negro wench named Jude. 5th I give and bequeath unto my beloved son, Harrison Moore one negro lad named Harry. 6th I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter

Catharine Moore, one girl named Lacey — 7th I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Jenny Moore, one negro woman named Pelfria and her child named Daphna — 8th I give & bequeath to my beloved son Reuben Moore, one negroman named Menor, and one negro boy named Peter — 9th I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Polly Sibly Moore, one negro girl named Moriah also one man named Anna — 10th I give and bequeath unto my beloved son, Sedson Moore, one negro boy named Jacob — 11th I desire that my negro woman Cathine may not serve any person after my death as a slave but shall have it in her power to live where she likes best — 12th My desire is that all my just debts shall be paid after that all my Estate that is not willed shall be sold and equally divided between all my children to wit, one negroman named Moses, and all the rest of my Estate I constitute and appoint my wife Cloe Moore, and my sons Francis Moore and Harrison Moore, Executors to this my last will & Testament. Revoking and making void all other wills heretofore made by me Publishing and declaring this my last will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal This 17th day of November, eighteen hundred and two.
