In the name of God Amen This Twelfth day of April in the year
of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven hundred and ninety one I Richard Parker
Senior, of Halifax County being Sick and Weak of Body But of perfect mind and
Memory do make this my Last Will and Testament in Manner and form as follows
First it is my Will and desire that part of my Land be Sold to pay my Just debts
that is all that part of my Land that Lays on the South Side of an old Road that
leads from Boyds Ferry to Banister River at Walls Ford the Said part of the Land
also Joins James Blackbourns and James Wilsons

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Item. It is my Will and desire that what money is Left that Arise from the Sale
of the above named Land after my Debts is paid my Beloved Wife Frances dispose of
it or keep it as she thinks proper.

Item. It is my will that my Beloved Wife Frances do Enjoy and possess the Remainder
part of my Land with all the appurtenances thereunto Belonging During her Natural
Life or Widowhood.

Item. It is my will & desire that my Beloved Wife Frances do Enjoy and possess

Memory do make this my Last Will and Testament in Manner and form as follows.

First it is my Will and desire that part of my Land be Sold to pay my Just debts that is all that part of my Land that Lays on the South Side of an old Road that leads from Boyds Ferry to Banister River at Walls Ford the said part of the Land also I give James Blackwell and Andrew Truan.

Item. It is my Will and desire that what money is Left that arys from the Sale of the above named Land after my Debts is paid my Beloved Wife Frances dispose of it or keep it as she thinks proper.

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Item. It is my will that my Beloved Wife Frances do Enjoy and possess the Remainder part of my Land with all the appurtenances therunto Belonging During her natural Life or Widow Hood.

Item. It is my will & desire that my Beloved Wife Frances do Enjoy and possess all the Remainder of my whole Estate during her Widow Hood and at my Wifes Decease or marriage all my Land that is then Remaining unsold as also all the Remainder of my whole Estate shall all be Sold and the money arising

from thence shall be Equally divided amongst my Children hereafter nam'd to wit;
John, Richard, Thomas, William, Francis, Judith, Elisabeth, Mary, Martha, Debella,
& Anne Mather.

Item I do constitute and ordain and appoint my Beloved Wife Frances as also my
Sons John & Richard Parker Sole Executors of this my last will and Testament that I
will have Executed after my Death utterly Revoking and disallowing all and Every other Will
or Wills or Testaments by me before made given or granted Owning Ratifying Acknowledging
and Confirming this and no other ^{Halifax County, Virginia Wills 1792-1797} ~~my last will and~~ Testament that I will have
Executed after my Death. In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal

this Twelfth day of April 1791.

And on the motion of John Parker one of the Executors therein named who made oath according to law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining Probate thereof in due form by giving Security.

Whereupon the said John Parker with Tony Daniel, Royall Daniel and Richard Parker his
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Securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the Penalty of Three thousand Dollars
Conditions according to law for that Purpose. Reserving Liberty to Francis Parker the
Executrix and Richard Parker the other Executor named therein to Join in the Execution
thereof when they shall think fit.
