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In the Name of God amen. I Stott: Mag of Halifax County do constitute and ordain this my last will and testament Item I leav^d unto my woman Isabella the land and plantation where I now live during her life to make use of for her benefit. I also leav^d her as much of my moveable estate as she see cause to keep during her life at her death the land with all the moveable estate that she keeps in her hands to be sold and the money to be equally divided between all my children.

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movable Estate that she chose to give up in her lifetime that to be sold and the money to be equally divided between my four youngest children namely Nicholas, Tit, Thomas and John Hay also what money is due me that to be equally divided between my four youngest children Nicholas, Tit, Tho: and John. Unlawfully I appointed my two quires ~~Frederick Hudson and Alexander~~ but my Executors
