 my son Hugh Moseley One hundred Pounds to be paid
 by my Executors out of the price of my land when divided
 and my feather bed to him and his heirs forever. Item. I give

 Pounds out of the money to be received by my executors to her
 and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my
