Man named Will and all my wearing Cloaths My desire is
that my Tract of Land in Sunnysburg County be sold to
pay my Debt. Item I give to my loving Friend Peter
Hudson all my wearing Tools my desire is that my
Whole Estate in the hands of my Friend Radford Maury
