Estate where with it hath pleased God to bless me with in the
Year 1790 I give and bequeath in manner and form following
Viz First of all I lend to Elizabeth Tribble my Wife my
House and Plantation as also my Mill with all the Land
Below the mouth of Jolly Branch on cow creek and Meadow
Branch on Childers Creek bounded by cow creek for a
North Line of John Dyers Line for a South Line together with
Sixty acres East of my Plantation due to me from George
Morris of Manover county all of which I lend as aforesaid
During the term of her Life the same Land and Premises
together with the Appurtenances I give and bequeath to Abner
Tribble my youngest son to him and his Heirs forever
I also give and bequeath to Spilbey Tribble my first born
Son all the Land on the North side cow creek belonging to
Tract whereon I dwell to him and his Heirs forever. I also
give and bequeath to William and Benjamin Tribble my Middlemost
Son all the Land of this same tract lying on my west Side
bounded with cow creek for North line and John Dyers line
for South Line extending down to the above mentioned Jolly
Branch on the aforementioned cow creek and Meadows Branch on
Childers Creek Equally divided between them and to them and
their Heirs forever. I Winifred Tribble my only Daughter I give
and bequeath my land on runaway Creek containing two
Hundred Acres to her and her Heirs forever and as touching my
Remainder Estate I amply working tools I lend to Elizabeth my Wife
During the term of her life and what remains after her Death

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I will may be equally divided amongst my four Sons and Daughters
my aforementioned Wife I have in care with my Wife in order
that each one of my sons may have the use of the same to do
the act and my story of trade for which each of them may be
Lastly I make constitute and appoint John Adams my son
and John Trill my brother and Elizabeth Trill my wife
only and sole Executors and Administrators of this my Last will
and Testament after annulling and revoking all other wills
and Testaments gifts or legacies or any other bequeathments
here at any aforementioned ratifying and confirming
this and no other to be my Last will and Testament I do
