In the Name of God Amen I Sandy Turner of the County of
Halifax being sick and weak of body but of a sound mind and
Memory praised be god for the same and calling to mind the morta-
lity of man do Make constitute and ordain this to be my last Will
and Testament in manner and form following to wit: I give
and bequeath to my beloved Brother Thomas Turner all my tract
of Land Adjoining Thomas Starfield John Irving James Scott
and Hugh Dragg to him and his heirs and Assigns forever together
with all my Stock plantation utensils and every part and
parcel of my estate be it of what nature kind or quality soever
to him and to his heirs and Assigns he paying all my just debts
In Testimony I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my
Seal this Eighth day of March in a decade 1743

At a Court held for Halifax County the 22 day of April 1793
The within written Last Will and Testament of Sandy Turner
and was exhibited in Court the same was proved by the Oaths
of three Witnesses thereto Subscribed and Ordered to be Recorded
And at an other Court held for Halifax County the 23 July 1793
On the motion of Thomas Watkins one of the Executors named
in the said Will certificate was granted him for obtaining probate
thereof ^{having taken the oath of} giving security whereof he together with Jno Brandon
and Caleb Turners his securities entered into and acknowledged.
