In the name of God amen I Tivy Daniel of the County of Halifax and Parish of Antrem, being sick, but of good sense, and memory, do hereby declare this to be My last Will and Testament, in manner and form following that is to say after paying all just debts, I give unto my daughter Fanny Woodrige Daniel my whole estate both real and personal but if she should die without lawfull issue, then and in that case, I give the tract of land and plantation unto my Nephew Jeremiah Daniel and in case of my daughters death, without lawfull issue I give unto Elizabeth Parker one negroe Girl named Dicy and in case of the death of my said daughter without issue lawfully Begotten, I desire that all the rest of my negroes may be divided among all my Brothers children and the children of Kirtley Pomeroy at the discretion of my executors hereafter named. I do constitute and appoint my Brother David Daniel & John Parker executors to this my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 4th day of February 1800

And on the motion of David Daniel one of the executors therein named who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining probate thereof in due form, he giving security whereupon the said David Daniel with William Terry, Royall Daniels and Robert Terry his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of fifty Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs liberty being reserved to John Parker the other executor to join in the execution thereof when he shall think fit.
