my last Will and Testament in manner and form following first and principally
desire that all my just Debts may be paid after what and my funeral Expenses being
paid as touching my realty Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with I give
and Devise and Dispose of the same as follows to wit. I give and Devise that my loving
Wife Francis shall have Two hundred and twenty five Acres of Land being One half
the Tract I now hold in Halifax County and all the Improvements thereon
During her natural life and after her Decease I give and Devise the same to my Son Moore
Comer to him his heirs and Assigns forever. I also give and bequeath to my said Wife
all my Stocks of Horses Cattle Sheep hogs Henshats Lye and plantation of every
kind whatsoever and also I give my said wife Besides what I have already mentioned
Every Negro that I am possessed with During her natural life and after her Decease
I give and Devise that my son John Comer shall have my Negroes Stephen Lucy
and Little Rose with their future increase of any so long as he lives and after his

I also Desire that my son Nath^l Jones shall have my Negro Girl Delcy and her
future Increase increase to him and his heirs forever also I desire that he shall have

that my son Charles Jones shall have my Negro Woman Mirrean and Fells and
Two thousand Weight of Tobacco that I send my son Moses Jones to give him,
in part of his Legacy to him his heirs and Offspring forever I also Desire that my

Daughter Pally Foulkes my Negro Girl (Place with her future increase and my
Negro boy Lige to her and the heirs of her Body forever and also I Desire that my son
Moses Jones shall have my Negro Boy Isaac and my Girl Fells to him his heirs
forever likewise I give unto my Grand Daughter Nancy Jones Daughter of my
Daughter Frances Jones my Negro Girl Betty her and her future Increase of my
to her and the heirs of her Body forever I also Give and Bequeath to my son Nath^l
Jones three hundred and forty eight Acres land on the North bank of Chesapeake

to him his Heir and Assigns forever and also I give and Devise to my son Andrew Torian
the Remainder part of my Land I now live on to him his Heir and Assigns forever
and there is two hundred ^{and fifty two} Acres of Land Accuracy that I bought of Hugh Mayberry

Torian and Pally Faulkner to them their Heir and Assigns forever I also give my Grand

The within Written Last Will and Testament of Thomas Jones ^{decd} was Exhibited in
Court by John Jones one of the Executors named and the same was proved by the
Oaths of three Witnesses ^{Thomas Jones, Virginia Will 1794-1797} the Will and Will of the said Thomas &
James to be devised and on the motion of the said Executor who made Oath that
Certificate was granted here for Attacking probate hereof in due form by giving Security
whenever he lay there with Nathaniel Terry John Stegner and John Handley his
Executors entered into & acknowledged that Bond in the penalty of £4000 (considered
as the said debts & debts being assumed in the other Cases to be in the probate
when they shall be Cause
