Coroner for said County aforesaid upon the View of the Body of
Daniel Last of this County then and there Lying Dead and upon
the Oath of Ewen Bagland Peter Roberts &c. Good and Lawfull

Men of the County aforesd, Who Being sworn and Charge to Enquire on
of the Commonwealth Where how and in what manner the s^d
Thomas Daniel came to his death do say upon their oaths
that one Thomas Luck late of the County aforesaid Not having

Devil on the Thursday day of November 1794 with fire and
Arms at the house of John Nash in the County aforesd Did then &
there give to the s^d Tho^s Daniel sundry Wounds with a Knife in his hand
and one Mortal Wound in his Belly Feloniously by his malice & ore thought
against the Peace and Obedy of this Commonwealth and the jurors upon the
Oath do say that the said Tho^s Daniel Dyed of the Wounds aforesd on the
fifteenth Day of November 1794 and that Thomas Luck aforesd is
Guilty of the Murder and Felony aforesd.
