of my Executors here after named and as for what worldly Estate it hath pleased  
God to bless me with I give and bequeath in manner following that is to say  
I give all my Just debts are paid I give to my Sons John, Christopher and  
Isaac and my Daughters Sarah and Abigail one Shilling Sterling each  
I give to my son John Richman one Shilling Sterling I then I give to  
my son Robert Richman the Land whereon I now live during his life and  
afterwards as I find it to his Wife during her widowhood and then I give it to  
my Grandson Robert Richman and I then I give that the Rest of my Estate may  
be sold and equally divided between my son Robert Richman's Children and my  
Daughter Mary Madams's Children. I then I appoint Robert Richman and  
Robert Wainwright Executors of this my last Will and Testament 12th March 1761

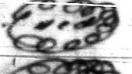
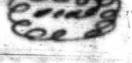
