At a Court held for Halifax County the 23^d day of October 1797

The within written last Will and Testament of Thomas Whitlow dec^d was exhibited in Court and proved by the oaths of Two of the Witnesses thereto Subscribed and ordered to be Recorded. And on the motion of Daniel Goode one of the Executors therein named who made oath according to law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining Probate thereof in due form he giving Security: Whereupon the said Daniel Goode with Newton Jones and Bartlett Elliott his securities entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the Penalty of Five Thousand Dollars Condition'd according to law for that Purpose. Reserving liberty to Joseph Conson the other Executor to join in the Execution thereof when he shall think fit =
