Am on the 5th day of May in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & Eighty two, I William Wili of Halifax County being sick and Weak of Body but of perfect minde Wili. Memory. Thanks be to God therefore calling to mind the Mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make Constitute and ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner and form following that is to say after all my legal Debts & funeral charges are justly paid. I give and dispose of in the following manner of form, Imprimis. I give and bequeath unto my son John Wili Two hundred acres of land being the upper part of my land joining Miller Road and Licking Creek and after the decease of my wife, my desire is that he shal have all the remainder of my land taking his share per my further will and desire is that after the death of my wife Elizabeth Wili all my whole estate consisting of everything I now enjoy and possess (land excepted) shall be equally divided between my sons George & John Wili. and Roy Boyd. Son of David and Elizabeth Boyd. and I further desire that of the said Roy Boyd's part falls to him before he comes of years to take it into his own hands. That it may be put out upon Interest until he comes of age. And whereas at present two children is now living with me of the names of Mary Clinches & Wili Spencer Clinches. I desire if they continue to live with my family until they marry or come of age either one or both of them shall have of my Estate a good share to add to their inheritance.
