bridle After my Wife's death all my Land except the aforesaid tract which
I give unto my son Booker is to be equally divided among my five Daugh-
ters, Sally, Meeky, Susan, Polly and Coley, All the rest of my Estate
after the Death of my Wife is to be equally divided among my six above
named children Lastly, I nominate, constitute and appoint Billy Bomar
John Bomar, and Fielding Bomar to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament
