In the Name of God Amen April the 8th one thousand seven hundred & seventy one William Echols of Halifax County being in perfect mind and memory but calling to mind the mortality of my Body and knowing it is appointed for all men to die do make and beain this my last will of Testament that is first of all at my decease I recommend my Soul into the hands of God that gave it and also my Body to the Earth to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named nothing doubting but the general resurrection I shall receive my own or such Body as it shall please God to give me and as touching my worldly Estate which with it hath pleased God to give me I give & bequeath

of in manner and form as followeth. I do hereby bequeath
Said Estate my Wife my Land I now live on together
with my Com. Will. Thacker standing with all my personal
Estate doth due by account also Robert my son doth have
during the Time of his life my just debt to be paid out of
the same and at death to be equally divided amongst
all my Children that now living and Abner Echols and
Said Echols my Grand Children be quiet with my
Children that now living. I give and bequeath the same
Land Mill & all the Appurtenances thereunto belonging
to my Grandson Joseph Hestrey Son of my daughter
Judith deceased of his heirs forever. I give & bequeath
unto Abner Echols my Grand Son a certain Tract of
Land lying in Pittsylvania County between Rich & S
Brown & others lines containing four hundred & 200 Acom
and his heirs forever. I give and bequeath unto Sarah
Echols my Granddaughter one certain Tract of Land lying
in Halifax County on the north side of Roanoke
River that I purchased of Robert Wood to her and her
heirs forever. Lastly I make and make manifest
John & William Echols my Sons and Monr Hendrick
my Son in Law my only ^{sole} Executors of this my
last will & Testament And I do utterly deny revoke
and disannul all other Wills Gifts Bequests or legacies
at anytime before named Notifying & concerning this
and no other to be last will & Testament In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Day and
Year above written
