same more or less, whereon he now lives; Also one mare & two cows which he has in cur-
rent possession also Twenty Shillings of my personal Estate -
I Wend, I lend to my beloved wife Mary Tynes the use of my lands Stock & house-
hold furniture (My just Debts being first paid) during her Natural Life, & after her
decease, to be Equally Divided Among my seven Daughters viz., Winifred, Martha, Elizabeth, Sarah,
Susanna Mary Locket & Deborah Locket Tynes & my will is farther that my three
Daughters viz., Susanna, Mary Locket & Deborah Locket Tynes have one year schooling
out of my Estate before the Division be made if not schooled before my Decease -
Lastly, I constitute & appoint Henry Barnes Jr. & Jomadal George Executor of
this my Last Will & Testament - In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and Seal this 16th day of December In the year of our Lord Christ One Thousand
Seven hundred and ninety four
