Jesse Stanley, Anna Stanley, Peggy Tiller, Elizabeth, Hulda Stone, Emily Stone, Harriet Vaughan & my grand daughter Sarah Louisa Ford, who is to have the share I would have given her mother Frances Ford had she survived me. Fourth. I appoint my son Jesse Stanley my executor of this my last will and I do not require him to give security as Executor having full confidence in his ability & integrity, and I desire that he should manage my estate during his mother's life, and that he will do all in his power to make her comfortable.
