Copy of the Will of Benjamin F. Dassel.

In the name of God Amen.

I Benjamin F. Dassel of the County of Caroline being of sound mind and disposing memory do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament.

Item I give and bequeath unto my dear Wife Maria B. Dassel, all my estate both Real and personal of every description whatsoever to her and her heirs for ever after the payment of my just debts.

Item It is my Wish that my estate both Real & personal be subject to the payment of my ^{just} debts.

Item It is my desire, that my brother in law John I. Anderson and my brother H. C. Dassel act as my Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
