Copy of the Will of Charles Mills.

In the name of God Amen

I Charles Mills of the County of Hanover and State of Virginia
do hereby make this my last Will and Testament, revoking all others.

It is my Will that all my just debts be paid also my funeral
expenses.

I give unto my Daughter Polly Hallaway all the Remainder
of my land lying in Louisa County supposed to be one hundred acres
more or less and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten forever.

I give unto my well beloved Wife Sarah Mills all my estate real and
personal during her natural life.

I give unto my Son Charles Mills the land upon which I reside
containing one hundred and twenty six and a half acres. I also give unto my
Son Charles Mills one Hundred dollars to him and his heirs lawfully
begotten forever.

After the death of my wife it is my Will that all my estate except that
already disposed of above to be equally divided amongst my surviving
children & my two grand daughters.
(My son) My sons. Robert Skille. Robert Skille. Polly Hanning my
grand daughter Wade Skille. Nathaniel Skille. Jackson Skille and my
grand daughters Elizabeth Meigsen and Susan Woodfin upon the
following terms to wit: That my son Wade Skille pay unto my Executors
for the benefit of my estate one hundred and eight pounds twelve
shillings and my son Jackson Skille pay Fifty three pounds eleven
shillings for the benefit of my estate and my son Robert Skille
the sum of thirty pounds eighteen shillings for the benefit of
my estate. It is my Will that if anything remains over and above
one hundred & seven pounds six shillings which my
son Charles M. Skille has already had of me that it
shall be equally divided between my Grand Daughters
Elizabeth Meigsen and Susan Woodfin them three and
one daughter and if any of my Executors die without

Children it is my Will that their portions of my Estate shall
be equally Divided amongst the Survivors and in every case
shall descend, To the lawful heirs of their bodies.
And Lastly I appoint my Sons Charles Miller Robert Mills and
Wade Mills, my executors to this my last Will and Testament
Given under my Hand and Seal this 6th day of February the
Thousand eight hundred and twenty Seven
