Copy of the Will of Daniel Stewart.

In The name of God Amen.

Daniel Stewart of the County of Henrico & State of Virginia
being of sound and disposing mind, and body do make this
my last, will and Testament as follows;
I desire after my decease, all of my just debts, be paid as soon as
may be convenient.

I leave and bequeath unto my wife, Harriet, Stewart all of
my estate, both real and personal after paying my debts to her
to hold for her own use, and benefit during her natural life
and also my single daughter, Mary D. Stewart who shall have a home
in the said property as long as she remains single or unmarried or
unmarried as she may desire it, but after the death of my wife I desire
that all my property be sold by my executor herein after named and
equally divided between first daughters, namely Agnes, Talley, Rebecca
and Mary D. Stewart.

I Inquire Catharine D. Borge Elizabeth Richardson and Mary Stewart and I bind unto my Son W. H. Stewart and his heirs during their natural lives the lot of land upon which I reside containing light or two acres more or less which I value at one hundred acres.

I do hereby nominate and appoint John P. Borge as my Executor to be my executor of this my last Will and Testament. I do hereby revoke and make void all former Wills heretofore made by me and declare this to be and contain my last Will and Testament. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand, and seal, this ^{2nd} day of May 1866.
