

In the name of God I Daniel Stewart of the County of Hanover &
State of Virginia being of sound and disposing mind and body do
make this to be my last will and testament, as follows, I desire after
my decease all of my just debts be paid as soon as may be convenient
first, I limit and bequeath unto my wife Harriet Stewart all of my
estate both real and personal after paying my debts to have and to
hold for her own use and benefit during her natural life and
also my single daughter Mary D Stewart shall have a home in the
said property as long as she remains single or unmarried or as
long as she may desire it, but after the death of my wife, I
desire that all of my property shall be sold by my executor
hereinafter named and equally divided between my first daugh-
ters namely Agnes Talley, Rebecca Ingram, Catharine D Boaz,
Elizabeth Richardson and Mary D Stewart. and I limit unto my son
Wm D Stewart and his wife during their natural lives the lot of
land upon which he resides containing eight or ten acres more
or less which I value at five hundred Dollars. And I do hereby
nominate and appoint John P Boaz without security to be my
executor of this my last will and testament. I do hereby revoke
and make void all former wills heretofore made by me, and
do declare this to be and contain my last will and testament
In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this 2^d day of May 1860

and upon which he claims an annuity of eight or ten dollars
or of which I value at five hundred Dollars. And I do hereby
nominate and appoint John P. Boaz without security to be my
executor of this my last will and testament. I do hereby revoke
and make void all former wills heretofore made by me, and
do declare this to be and confirm my last will and testament
