

I Edmund Wash of the County of Hanover State of Virginia
do make and ordain this my last last will and testament
in manner and form as follows to wit
1st Giving to my wife Nancy Wash all my estate of every
description so long as she may live and no longer.
2^d After the death of my wife I direct my Executors herein-
after named to sell all my estate both real and personal
except slaves and have the whole of my Estate including
slaves divided into seven equal shares. One of which shares
I leave in the hands of my Executors to be held by them
for the Children of my deceased daughter Emily D.
Gannon and the income to be used for the Schooling and
maintainance of the said Children until they attain the
age of 21 years and as they attain the age of 21 years
their sutable portion is to be delivered to them. One other
share I leave in hands of my Executors to be held by them
for the Children of my deceased son Richard Wash, Lucy
Ann Wash, widow of the said Richard Wash to have a
support from this share as long as she remains his
widow, and the income to be used or as much as is
necessary for the Schooling and maintainance of the said
Children until they attain the age of 21 years and as the
said Children attain the age of 21 years their sutable
portion is to be delivered to them. One other share I bequeath

portion is to be delivered to them, One other share I bequeath to my son William Wash and at his death to his children - One other share I bequeath to my son James C. Wash and at his death to his children.

One other share I leave in the hands of my Executors to be held by them for my daughter Susan M. Chick and her child or children the income to be paid annually to the said Susan M. Chick during her life and in the event of her death before her child or children attain the age of 21 years I direct my Executors to hold the share as aforesaid and use the income for the maintenance & schooling of the said child or children and deliver the share to the said child or children when they attain the age of 21 years. One other share I bequeath to my daughter Sarah A. Walton and at her death to her children. One other share I bequeath to the children of my deceased daughter Ellen V. Mitchell to be managed by their father W. V. Mitchell until they attain the age of 21 years and then to be delivered to them.

In the event of the death of any of my grand children before they attain the age of 21 years their portion shall revert to their brothers and sisters or the children of the deceased if they shall have none and the balance of the estate & whatever
